Dear Customer,

The District has provided two separate notices about its Water Service Line Inventory Project, which is a component of a new regulatory requirement, the Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR), set by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP).

According to our records, we have not received a survey submission from you indicating the type of material your water service line is made of. If we do not receive a survey from you by the end of January, Raybern Consulting will begin scheduling/conducting door-to-door inspections to document this information in February 2024.

Please review and complete the two steps below:

**Step 1: Learn How to Find and Identify Your Water Service Line**

Scan the first QR code on the front to help you determine where your water service line is located and what your water service line is made of. You may have to perform a "scratch test" in order to determine your service line material. **YOU WILL NEED TO TAKE A PHOTO ON YOUR MOBILE DEVICE OR TABLET IN ORDER TO SUBMIT THE INSPECTION FORM!**

**Step 2: Complete the District's Water Service Line Inventory Form**

Scan the second QR code on the front and complete the inventory form. You will need to upload a photo of your service line to this form.
