PROJECT OVERVIEW




- Water distribution system improvements, including new water main, fire hydrants, valves, and the District-owned portion of each property's water service line.
- **Project Limits:** East Street, Dedham
 - **Phase 1:** Greenwood Avenue to Norwich Street
 - **Phase 2:** Norwich Street to Vincent Road
- Entire project includes the Installation of approximately 3,800 linear feet of 8-inch & 12-inch Water Main

PHASE I


- Greenwood Avenue to Norwich Street
- **Installation Complete:**
 - ~1,800 LF of 8-inch & 12-inch Water Main
 - Hydrants & valves
- **In Progress/Upcoming:**
 - Pressure Testing/Disinfection of new main
 - Side street tie-ins*
 - Water service transfers*

*Anticipated to start Week of 4/28/2025,
subject to change




PHASE II

- Norwich Street to Vincent Road
- Overview:
 - Installation of ~2,000 LF of 12-inch and 8-inch water main
 - Temporary water main
 - Fire hydrants and valves
 - Replacement of the District-owned portion of the water service line
- In Progress/Upcoming:
 - Install a temporary water main
 - Transfer customers over to the temporary water main




TEMPORARY WATER MAIN





➤ Setup:


- Contractor lays and fuses pipe
- Driveway crossings will be either ramped or buried in a trench
- Individual home connections will be ramped



TEMPORARY WATER MAIN


- Home Connections:
 - DWWD will provide notice in advance of work
 - DWWD will need to schedule a time to access your home to shut off the meter
 - The contractor will then connect the hose to the home's external spigot
 - If an external spigot is not available, the bypass may be tied in underground at your curb stop or connected internally after the meter






TEMPORARY WATER MAIN


- Breakdown – reverse the process!
 - Your home will be tied into the new water main. PLEASE FLUSH YOUR WATER SERVICE!!!
 - The contractor will remove the connection to the spigot
 - DWWD will notify in advance and schedule a time to turn on the water meter in the basement and, if necessary, replace the water meter.



CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE*




- Phase 1: Ongoing, Expected through Mid-May 2025
- Phase 2: Mid-May 2025 through Fall 2025
 - Temp WM Install: Week of April 14, 2025
 - Water Main Installation: Week of May 5, 2025*
 - Water Service Transfers: Mid/End of August 2025*
- Typical Construction Hours
 - Monday-Friday, 7 AM to 4 PM
 - Nights & Weekends, if required





ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Traffic Delays
- Sidewalk Closures and Detours
- Unforeseen and Scheduled Water Disruptions
- Scheduled Access to Your Home/Basement
- To be maintained:
 - Driveway Access
 - Emergency vehicles
 - Trash & recycling trucks




ROAD CLOSURES/DETOURS



- No detours scheduled at this time
- Traffic Patterns:
 - One travel lane, with officers directing bi-directional traffic (8:30 am start time)
 - Two travel lanes open (7 am start time)




The above traffic patterns are dependent on scope and will vary through the course of work. Updates will be posted weekly on the project website.






